

Servier Laboratories (Ireland) Ltd. Methodological note for Transfer of Value (ToV) Disclosures

Introduction

From January 2016, member companies of the Irish Pharmaceutical Healthcare Association (IPHA), which represents the research-based pharmaceutical industry in Ireland, will make publicly available details of how we engage with and support healthcare professionals (HCPs) and healthcare organisations (HCOs) to provide better patient care. (HCP and HCO as defined by EFPIA). The information will be made public no later than 1st July of each subsequent year and will convey information about Transfers of Value (ToV) such as donations and grants (including medical education and unrestricted educational grants), consultancy fees, research and development, conference registration fees or travel costs to attend medical congresses that took place over the previous calendar year.

As members of the Irish Pharmaceutical Healthcare Association (IPHA), Servier Laboratories (Ireland) Ltd. (SLI) will proceed with this public disclosure of ToVs made, directly or indirectly, to HCPs and HCOs.

This document describes the methodology employed by SLI in declaring these ToVs. This data was correct at time of publishing.

Definitions

Recipients – HCPs and HCOs (where their primary residence of practice is in the Republic of Ireland) in receipt of ToVs from SLI and any other legal entity of the Servier group.

ToVs: Direct and indirect transfers of value, whether in cash, in kind or otherwise, made, whether for promotional purposes or otherwise, in connection with the development and sale of prescription only medicinal products exclusively for human use.

Disclosure's scope

Products concerned – All products of Servier Laboratories (Ireland) Ltd.

Included ToVs – This ToV disclosure applies to HCPs and HCOs resident in Ireland.

ToVs date – Date when contract signed by HCP/HCO.

Direct ToVs – These are made directly for the benefit of a recipient.

Indirect ToVs – These are made for the benefit of a recipient, where his/her identity is known to or can be identified by the Company

Specificities for ToVs:

- In case of partial attendances or cancellation - If HCP registered to attend a meeting but subsequently cancels, then this will not be declared as receiving a ToV.

Cross-border activities - HCPs and HCOs (where their primary residence of practice is in the Republic of Ireland) who are in receipt of a ToV from SLI or any other entity from Servier Group will be disclosed in Republic of Ireland.

Specific considerations

Country unique identifier –:

- For HCP - use Irish Medical Council Number.
- For HCO - use SLI assigned code generated by the company.

Consent management

Consent collection – Data protection legislation requires consent of individuals to disclose ToV details. HCP Contracts include “Individual Disclosure” consent form. While data protection does not apply to HCOs, permission will be sought from a named representative to declare HCO ToVs and will be included HCO “Disclosure” Consent form.

Management of recipient consent withdrawal – prior to publically disclosing ToV, all HCPs and HCOs will be contacted with a summary of ToV and they will have the opportunity to withdraw consent at that stage if they wish. Any request to withdraw consent will be implemented within 3 weeks of notification. Where the company is made aware of a HCP who has retired or deceased, their name will be removed from the report.

Management of recipient’s request –any questions in relation to ToV and consent, please contact: tovdublin@servier.com

Partial consent – no partial consent. If a HCP/HCO has agreed to consent/permit, then consent/permission will be valid for 2 calendar years. If the HCP/HCO does not consent to disclosure of ToV, then request for consent/permission should be sought on the occasion of a subsequent engagement.

Multi-year agreements – HCP consent in the contract remains valid for 2 calendar years up until 31st December of the 2nd year.

Disclosure Form

Date of publication - by the end of June of the reporting calendar year.

Disclosure platform - IPHA Report

Disclosure language - English

Disclosure financial data

Currency - Euro

VAT included or excluded – Vat included where payable by SLI.

Calculation rules – according to predefined EFPIA categories.
